## 3 Night Iguazu Extension

### Day One

A transfer will take you from the Buenos Aires International Airport to Jorge Newbery Domestic Airport for your flight to Iguazu. Upon arrival, meet the transfer to your Iguazu Falls resort and check in for your 3 night stay. Enjoy a welcome dinner in the hotel's restaurant. (D)

### Day Two

After breakfast, your adventure begins on the Argentine side of the falls! On different footbridges, we will visit the heart of the waterfalls, appreciating them from different angles. We will visit the lower circuit and feel part of nature—refreshing ourselves with waterfall drizzle. On the upper circuit, we will stop at different viewpoints, and then reach the balcony at Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat). This is beyond doubt the most amazing of all the falls: water falls from 80 meters.



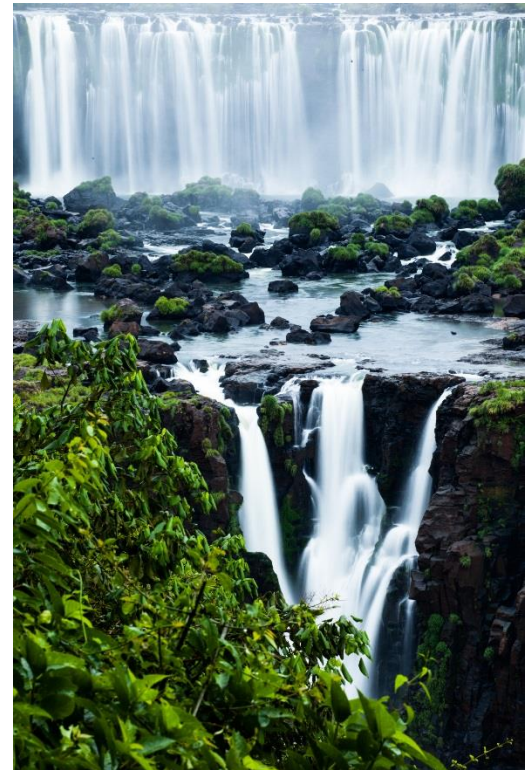
Board zodiac boats with your trusted guide and prepare to navigate three miles through the lower Iguazú river on these thrilling speed boats. You will be crossing one mile of rapids and get into the Devil's Throat Canyon approaching the water falls. Travel through the Canyon of the Iguazu River, until the falls. After enjoying the view from the calm side of San Martin Island, sail to the "Tres Mosqueteros" (Three Musketeers) waterfall for a breath-taking view of Devil's Throat. After that, sail along the shore of

the island until the most exciting part - the San Martin waterfall, a wonderful and unforgettable experience as it's the largest waterfall any motor-boat can approach safely. After your thrilling adventure on the falls, enjoy lunch and then back at your hotel to enjoy the rest of your evening at leisure. (B, L)



## Day Three

After having breakfast at the hotel, embark on a sightseeing tour of Iguazú Falls from the Brazilian side. Iguazú National Park bears the name of the river serving as northern border, which means 'great waters' in the Guaraní language. While taking in the magnificent sight of the falls, you will also get a great opportunity to discover the 2000 different species of flora, over 500 different kinds of birds and approximately 80 different mammals that surround the tropical rainforest of the falls. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before crossing the border and returning to your hotel for the evening at your leisure. (B, L)



## Day Four

After breakfast and hotel check out, a transfer will take you to the airport to fly back to Buenos Aires. Upon arrival, another transfer will be waiting to take you to your centrally-located Buenos Aires hotel for your Value Inclusive Package stay. Enjoy the rest of your time in Buenos Aires at your leisure. (B)

## **Mobility and Medical Advisement**

**People with the following conditions are not allowed to ride the boats of the Zodiac Navigation Tour:**

- People with osteoporosis, neck, back conditions or have had neck, back surgery
- People unable to climb 100 yards of stairs
- People with heart conditions
- People with COPD or neurological conditions
- People unable to handle a nautical emergency on the lower Iguazu River

### **Guests with mobility issues:**

The Iguazu Falls viewing decks consist of many levels of viewing platforms, only accessible by stairs. Guests must be able to climb up and down multiple stairs on own in order to take in the spectacular views. Unfortunately, guests in wheelchairs will not be able to participate in the tours on this extension.
