Wind along the Antrim Coast to the Giant's Causeway, one of Ireland's amazing natural wonders; visit Londonderry on a locally guided tour and enjoy the Ulster American Folk Park and the sights of Belleek as you wish. Stop in Sligo to visit Yeats' grave and have lunch at beautiful Kylemore Abbey before driving past the bogs and heathland of Connemara en route to your Galway hotel. Savor breathtaking ocean views at the Cliffs of Moher, soaring 700 feet high over the rocky shores below, dine on traditional Irish fare in Ennis with musical entertainment to match, and stay at an 18th-century manor house, steeped in cultural charms. Learn about Emerald Isle farming during lunch with the owners of a dairy farm in Kilmallock, loop
